## **Phonics and Literacy**

This half term in phonics we will continue with phase 2 sounds and tricky words. We will still be carrying on making verbal sentences to develop their knowledge and understanding of how sentences are structured. We will be focusing on reading CVC and CCVC words to increase our reading fluency.

Within Literacy we will be making lists, cards and invitations to go with this half terms topic of 'Transport'. Our focus text will be linked to this topic and will be 'Naughty Bus' and 'The Jolly Postman'.

We will continue work on pencil grip, writing their names, letter formation and using their phonic knowledge to support them with reading & segmenting and writing words.

#### **RE**

This half term, the children will be learning about "God's Family". The children will be given opportunities to know that Angel Gabriel asked Mary to be the mother of God's son. That in Advent we prepare to celebrate Christmas. To know the story of the birth of Jesus and reflect on how important this is for us. That the shepherds were the first to hear about the birth of Jesus.

They will learn that God made us to know and love him, as well as to show our love for him by helping one another.

## **Mathematics**

<u>Subitising:</u> we look at numbers to 5, looking at different arrangements.

Cardinality, ordinality and counting: we will explore the cardinality of number (knowing the last number counted is the total), linking this into dice patterns & 5 fingers on 1 hand, counting out loud beyond 10. Numeral recognition.

<u>Composition:</u> explore the concept of the 'part-part-whole' concept. We will continue to explore the composition of numbers within 5 (how they are made up of other numbers, early addition, and subtraction).

<u>Comparison:</u> compare sets using a variety of strategies, including 'just by looking' (subitising) and by matching. Comparing groups to see if they have 'more, less or the same / equal' amount.

### **Topic: Transport**

We are looking at different forms of transport, how we can travel around, jobs they are used for such as delivering post, food etc. Also, who uses transport to help us such as police, fire and paramedics. We will be looking at how transport has changed from the past to present day. We are hoping to have a visit from the police to talk about road safety.

In the second half of the term, we will link travel into Christmas and how Father Christmas travels around the world and we will look at different countries he travels to.

## **Physical Development**

The children will continue to have their PE lessons on a Tuesday and Thursday. This half term we will be developing their knowledge of how to use the equipment safely, pair work and mounting and dismounting equipment.

The children will also be practising their fine motor skills through using scissor's and activities at the Funky Fingers table, as this will support their pencil grip.

## **PSED**

We have a weekly circle time session linked into the school's virtues which are discussed each week in Monday's main assembly.

As a class we constantly talk about feelings and how our actions might impact on a friend. Having the understanding and knowledge on how to build relationships in new social situations will help deepen their skills to confidently deal with new situations. We have started using the language of the Leader in me and linking it into knowledge gained in RE, the virtues and school life.
