Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back after the holidays! I hope you had a lovely week off and have had lots of fun enjoying the beautiful sunshine. I can't believe we are into our final half term, the bustiest half term of them all! The children have lots of lovely activities planned this half term. The catch-up sessions will continue this half term with a focus on phonics.

In English this half term the children will be focusing on the film clip 'The Clock Towers' where they will be using all the skills, they have learnt throughout the year to write a setting description and a narrative. With such an exciting half term and lots of events to look forward to, the children will write a recount, retelling events such as what they got up to in health week. A big focus this half term, will be on the children being able to proofread their writing and be able to make corrections independently. We will continue to have a grammar focus each week and will focus on specific areas of year 1 grammar.

In phonics this half term, the children will be recapping all phase 2, 3 and 5 phonemes and graphemes as well as continuing to practice all Year One common exception words and phase 2,3,4 and 5 tricky words. Each week our focus will be to implement our phonics into helping us spell accurately when writing, the weekly spelling test will continue to align with our weekly phonics. Please continue to use the spelling books to practise your child's weekly spellings as this really supports their confidence and learning in school. At the end of Summer 1 your child sat a test on their Year One common exception words which shows the words that your child needs to learn, these are in their spelling books. Please continue to look over these regularly especially the ones they are unsure of. Many of the children already know all the Year One common exception words, which is fantastic! Please begin to look over the Year 2 spellings which are in their spellings book.

We will continue to do our guided reading sessions in school to develop the children's reading skills. The children will continue to build on their fluency, expression and tone when reading aloud. Please continue to read frequently with your child at home, as well as asking them a range of questions about the story. We recommend that your child reads for a minimum of 10 minutes per day, reading out loud to an adult as this will really help your child's fluency.

In maths this half term, we will start by looking at place value to 100 and will continue to consolidate their knowledge of place value and tens and ones. They will also be tackling lots of problems linked to money so talking about the value of coins at home with your child would be extremely helpful for them. Lastly, the children will be learning about time, they will learn to tell the time at half past and o'clock. I will continue to send home the mental maths focuses as and when it is necessary, please practise this concept with your child ready for their mental maths tests in school.
