Dear Parents,

We are now in the final half term of Key Stage One which again is set to be a busy yet fun one! This has got off to a great start this week with a fun frisbee session on Tuesday. Next week will be Health Week along with sports day scheduled for later in the month which again is due to be action packed and full of laughs. We will also be getting ready for our final class assembly of the year where we will be celebrating some of our wonderful learning about over the year.

In English this half term, we will be looking at both fiction and non-fiction texts linked to the seaside. The children will be consolidating their use of expanded noun phrases to describe and looking at how to add detail and variety to their sentences by adding words which explain how things happen (e.g. quickly). An important part of this term's work will be encouraging independence in writing through editing work to make improvements. At the end of the half term, the children will have produced a setting description, retold a story and written a non-chronological report about a Yorkshire seaside town.

In maths this half term, we will be learning about time using the language hour, half hour, quarter to, quarter past and working on reading 5 minute intervals. The children will also learn how about measurement using the language of millilitres, litres, grams and kilograms. They will also work to solve problems using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division in these areas. The weekly mental maths sessions will continue and will be tested monthly.

Towards the end of the term we will be getting the children appropriately prepared and excited for their transition into KS2, please see dates below.
