Welcome back! I hope you all had a relaxing summer. I know from talking to the children that they have had a fun filled break catching up with family and friends which sounded lovely. I feel very lucky to be teaching this class again and look forward to making more memories together as we learn this year.

Year 4 are lucky to be supported in their learning this year by Mrs Wood and Mrs Shires. Mrs Georghiou will teach the children on a Wednesday.

In English this half term, we will be studying the author Roald Dahl, where we will be looking at character and setting descriptions and comparisons. We will also be producing some cross curricular writing. Persuasive writing will be studied alongside our topic of recycling in geography and R.E we will be producing book blurbs. We will have a specific grammar focus each week where we will look nouns and pronouns, conjunctions and adverbials. We will also continue to practise the Year 3/4 spelling words, homophones and spelling rules.

In maths this half term, we will be looking at place value, addition and subtraction. Every maths lesson will include fluency, reasoning and problemsolving elements and there will be plenty of opportunity to apply what we have learnt in real life scenarios. Every Friday, the maths lesson will be focused on arithmetic skills, mental maths and times tables. The children will have regular opportunities to practise their times tables each week.
