

Welcome back! I hope you all had a relaxing Summer- I know from talking to the children that they have had a fun filled break, catching up with family and friends which sounded lovely. Mrs Harrison feels very lucky to be teaching the class again and along with Mrs Robertshaw, is looking forward to making more memories together as we learn this year.

This year, Mrs Harrison will teach Monday to Wednesday and Mrs Robertshaw will teach on a Thursday and Friday. We are also very fortunate that we will have Mrs Middleton teaching art and DT, as well as some PE. Year 4 will be supported in their learning this year by Mrs Caldwell and Mrs Bartolotta.

In English this half term, we will be studying the well-known author Roald Dahl, where we will be writing a biography. We will also be looking at the book 'The Tin Forest' by Helen Ward, creating character and setting descriptions. The children will also write an explanation text within science.

We will have a specific grammar focus each week where we will look nouns and pronouns, conjunctions, and adverbials. We will also continue to practise the Year 3/4 spelling words, homophones and spelling rules. Watch out for our brand new spelling scheme being launched – the children will have fun, interactive ways to practice at home!

In maths this half term we will consolidate and extend our knowledge of place value, addition and subtraction. Every maths lesson will include fluency, reasoning and problem-solving elements and there will be plenty of opportunity to apply what we have learnt in real life scenarios. Every Monday, the maths lesson will be focused on arithmetic skills, mental maths and times tables. The children will have regular opportunities to practise their times tables each week.
