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Dear Parents/Carers,

Happy New Year! Welcome back to school after the Christmas break. I hope you had a relaxing holiday and enjoyed yourselves. On behalf of myself and the Year 4 staff, we would like to say a big thank you for all the cards, well wishes and generous gifts received for Christmas, we are very grateful. I am sad this will be my last term with the children but intend to fill it with lots of fun learning.

We will be carrying on with swimming this term. Please make sure the children come pool ready (swimming costumes/shorts under their P.E kits) and bring a towel, underwear and a snack.

In English, we will be using a picture book which follows the story of a boy who finds a camera at the beach and discovers unusual photos of 'flotsam'- various items discarded at sea. This continues to highlight the issue of pollution and will result in some persuasive and descriptive writing. We will also look at some non-fiction writing about rivers linked to our geography and produce a non-chronological report about the water cycle in science.

In maths this half term, we will be looking at multiplication and division, area and fractions. Every maths lesson will include fluency, reasoning and problem-solving elements and there will be plenty of opportunity to apply what we have learnt in real life scenarios. Every Monday, the maths lesson will be focused on arithmetic skills, mental maths and times tables. The children will have regular opportunities to practise their times tables each week. Please make sure they are practising regularly at home on times tables rockstars.
