Welcome back, I hope you all had a peaceful half term and managed to rest with the children. This half term is short and very busy so please be aware of the important dates!

The children are really enjoying swimming and are making great progress and becoming more confident each week. Please continue to make sure the children come pool ready (swimming costumes/shorts under their P.E kits) and bring a towel, underwear and a snack.

In English, we will be reading The Spiderwick Chronicles, with an emphasis on descriptive writing through character and setting descriptions. Our grammar focus when reading this text will be speech punctuation, apostrophes, expanded noun phrases and fronted adverbials.

In maths this half term, we will continue to look fractions and start work on decimals. Every day we will be working on times tables and once a week we will also have a short session on arithmetic skills and mental maths. Please make sure they are practising regularly at home on times tables rockstars.

Our history topic this half term is Ancient Greeks. The children will study when and where the Ancient Greeks lived, how they lived in separate city states, how their armies were structured and learn about Greek gods and myths. They will also consider its impact and legacy on the modern world.

Our Religious Education topic is Jesus the Saviour. We will learn that Jesus is truly God and, as man, truly human and learn that Jesus came to share our life so that we can share his life. We will study the events of Holy week and that when Jesus died on the cross, he took away our sins. We will learn all about Easter Sunday.
