Welcome back after the February half term holiday. We hope that you had a good rest! What an exciting half term we have! We have our exciting, fun packed residential in the next few weeks which is going to be amazing. Let's hope we get some good weather for the trip. If there are any queries then please do not hesitate to ask. Mrs Georghiou is extremely envious but is looking forward to hearing about all the wonderful activities we have done.

In our English lessons this half term, we will be studying- The Highwayman. This poem is a ballad (narrative) which tells a story of romance, robbery and tragedy. We know the class will love it! The poem will inspire several pieces of writing, including their own story based on the tragedy. Within our grammar starters and sessions, we will improve our knowledge and use of apostrophes as well as consolidating how we use punctuation for parenthesis and clarity. We will continue to practice the year 5/6 common exception words and other spelling patterns outlined on the half termly spelling sheet which has been sent home and is available on the website. Please encourage your child to continue practising their CEW spellings from the previous half terms as we will test these again in the last week of term.

In maths this half term, we will continue to learn about fractions and how to use them. We will continue to compare and order fractions less than and more than 1 and will then move on to adding, subtracting and multiplying fractions. Finally, we will learn to find fractions of amounts. Before the end of the half term, we will begin to understand decimal numbers – ordering, comparing, rounding and converting to fractions and percentages. We will continue to have our arithmetic skills lesson where we will also be working on our mental maths and times tables up to 12 x 12. Please encourage your child to practise their tables at home on Times Table Rockstars or Hit the Button to improve confidence and quick recall. If they need a worksheet to support instead, then please do not hesitate to ask.
