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Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back after the Easter holidays. We hope you had a good rest and managed to get out and enjoy yourselves despite the unseasonal wet weather. Hopefully, the children have fully recovered from our fabulous residential, are feeling refreshed and ready for a hard-working half term.

In English, we will begin the new term learning to write a detailed a non-chronological report based on a short film called Pandora. We will then be studying The Highwayman. This poem is a ballad (narrative) which tells a story of romance, robbery and tragedy. The poem will inspire several pieces of writing, including their own story based on the tragedy. Within our grammar starters, we will improve our knowledge and use of apostrophes as well as consolidating how we use punctuation for parenthesis and clarity.

In maths this half term, we will finish our topic on decimals and percentages and learn how we convert between them. We will also be learning to calculate area and perimeter and solving problems involving these before moving onto our statistics and shape topics later in the half-term.
