Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back! I hope you all had a wonderful holiday and are as excited to get back into school routine as we all are. The class seem to have had an action packed summer and are ready to get stuck into life in Year 6.

I have really enjoyed getting to know the children over the last week and I am finding lots of things out which will help us learn together throughout the year.

Year 6 are lucky to be supported in their learning this year by Mrs Wood in the mornings and some afternoons. Mr Lewandoski will be delivering PE lessons on Friday mornings. Mrs Robertshaw will teach the class on a Wednesday.

In English this half term, we will be studying the author, Louis Sachar and using a film clip about the Day of the Dead festival in Mexico. Through these texts, we will be working towards writing descriptions, diary entries, a non-chronological report and a persuasive leaflet. We will also be doing some biography writing through RE.

We will have a specific grammar focus each week where we will look at apostrophes, conjunctions, different tenses and determiners. We will also continue to practise the Year 5/6 spelling words, homophones and spelling rules.

In maths this half term, we will be looking at place value, number operations and fractions. In place value, we will be developing our conceptual understanding through comparing, ordering and rounding numbers and using this knowledge to reason. Every maths lesson will include fluency, reasoning and problem solving elements and there will be plenty of opportunity to apply what they have learnt in real life scenarios. Every Friday, the maths lesson will be focused on arithmetic skills, mental maths and times tables up to 12 x 12.
