In English this half term, we will be looking at the film Road's End where the children will write a dual perspective narrative. We will write a cross-curricular explanation on circulation through science as well as looking at the poem 'The Raven'. This half term we will be revising all the grammatical knowledge for Year 6 whilst also focusing on homophones and the Year 5/6 spelling words.

In maths this half term, we will first be finishing our shape topic, looking at 3D nets of shapes, then moving on to revising all the areas covered in the SATs papers. We will also have a short session each week working on arithmetic skills, mental maths and times tables up to 12 x 12.
