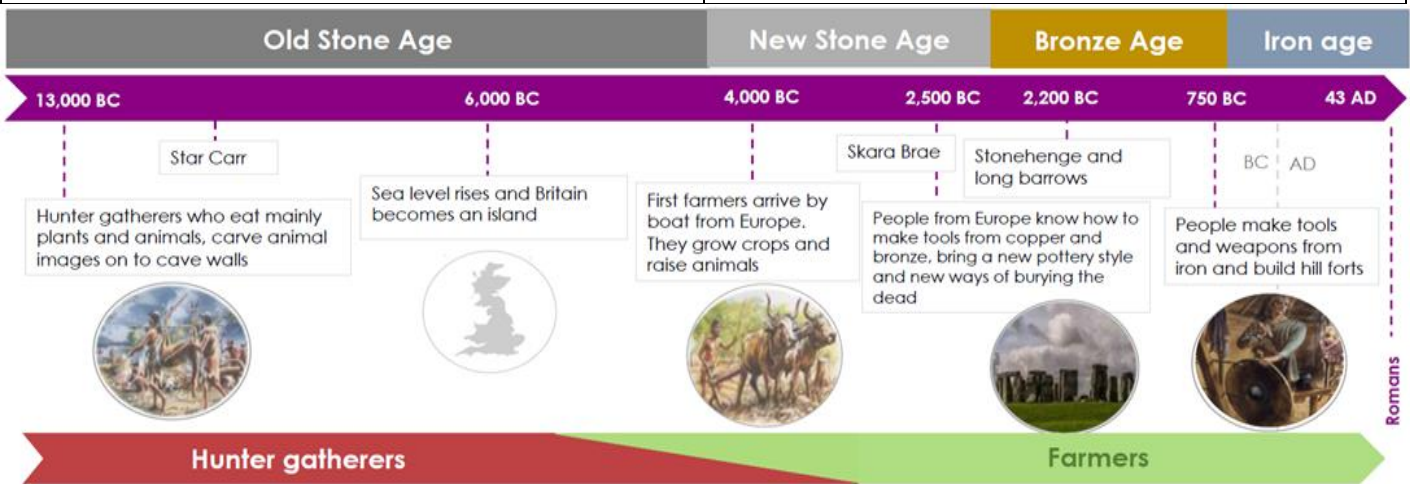


Year 3 – Stone Age–Iron Age – Autumn 2
