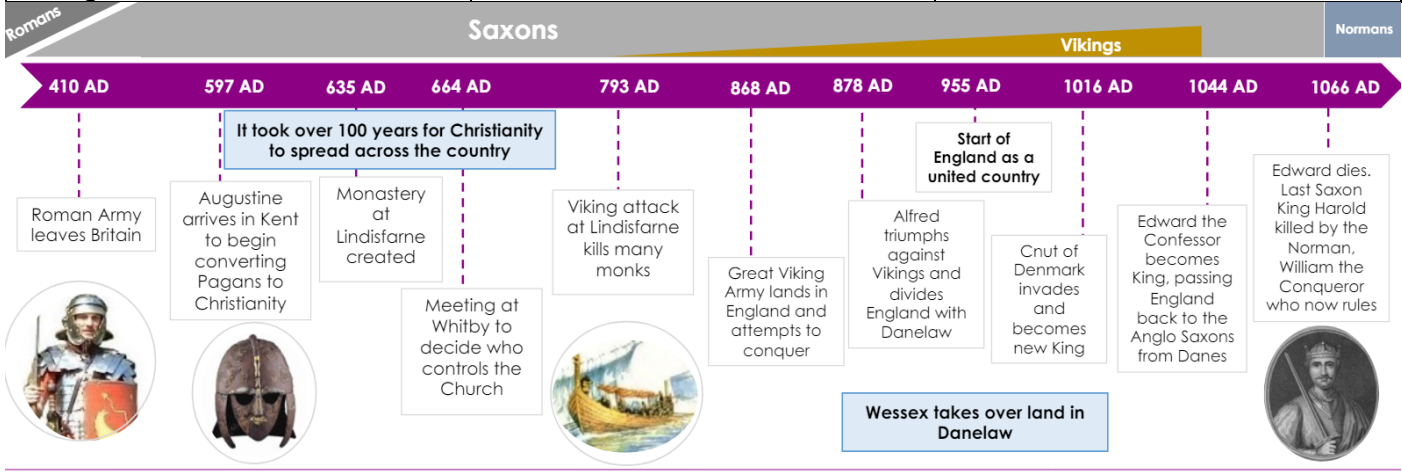
Year 5 – Anglo Saxons Settlement in Britain – Autumn 2 and Spring 2

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Stone Age was when early humans used tools from stone. This lasted until the Bronze Age. The Bronze Age began when settlers arrived from Europe to Britain. These settlers brought with them ways of making tools from metal (bronze). The Iron Age lasted from 800 BC till the Roman invasion (AD 43) - this was when people used tools made from iron. In AD 43, the Romans under the order of Emperor Claudius, first invaded Britain and Roman rule lasted until AD 410. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Reasons why the Anglo Saxons invaded Britain. Where the Anglo Saxons settled in Britain. How historians have learned about life in Anglo Saxon times (Sutton Hoo case study). During Anglo Saxon times England became a Christian country.
