



What should I already know?

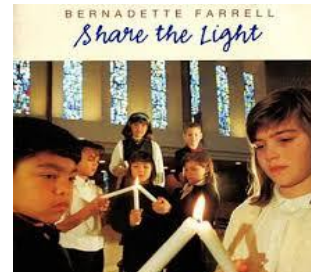
- That God created them and gave them gifts.

What will I know at the end of the unit?

- Know that Genesis is the first book of the Old Testament.
- Talk about being chosen and what it feels like.
- Give two examples of what the story of Abraham tells us about God.
- Use religious words like Abraham, Moses, Daniel, trust, faith, bravery, and slaves
- Retell simply, in any form, the story of God’s call of Abraham from Genesis.
- Ask and answer questions about the feelings of Abraham and Sarah.
- Retell simply, in any form, the story of baby Moses.
- Say what the name ‘Abraham’ means.
- Describe how Abraham showed his faith in God.
- Wonder and ask questions about the stories of Abraham and Moses and whether they have anything to say to them about being chosen, about promises and faith.
- Recognise that some questions are hard to answer.

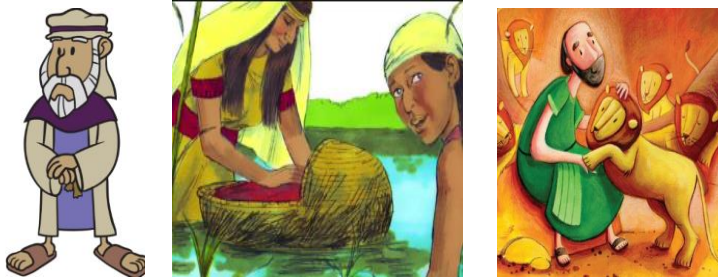
Key Vocabulary

Abraham	A Prophet called by God to settle in the promised land of Canaan. The name means “Father of many “.
Bravery	Courage to do something without fear.
Chosen	Picked to do something
Daniel	A Prophet and messenger of God who could interpret dreams.
Egypt	A country in North Eastern Africa.
Faith (for Christians)	Our belief in God.
Moses	A Prophet and leader who delivered his people from slavery.
Old Testament	The first part of the Christian Bible that tells the story of Gods chosen people
Pharaoh	A ruler in ancient Egypt.
Promise	When someone says they really will do something for you.
Slaves	People who are forced to do hard work by other people and they must do it.
Trust	When we can be sure that someone will only do what is good for us
