



What should I already know?

- Knowledge of the Passover and its meaning.
- The Mass – building on our learning from Yr. 2 and Yr. 4 about all the different elements of the Mass and their meanings to us and our lives.
- Knowledge of the events of Holy Week, particularly The Last Supper.

What will I know at the end of the unit?

- Show knowledge and understanding of the Last Supper by making links between it and the Passover and Eucharist (Mass)
- Show understanding of how the beliefs held about the Mass prompt Catholics to act in the world.
- Reflect on own beliefs and how they prompt action. Has the Mass anything to say to them about action in the world?
- Show knowledge and understanding of how beliefs are expressed in worship in different parts of the Mass (Penitential Act, Liturgy of the Word, Offertory, Consecration and Holy Communion)
- Show an understanding of the different ways that Jesus is present to us
- Show knowledge and understanding of the religious signs used in the celebration of the Eucharist.
- Express a point of view about the Eucharist, giving a reason for it
- Compare responses to questions about the Mass and or Eucharist

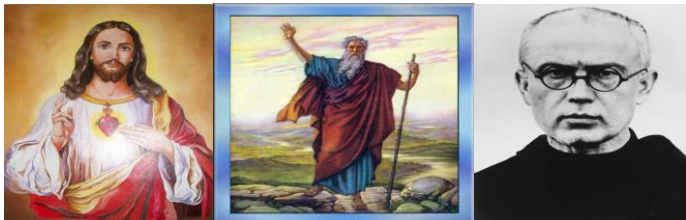
Key Vocabulary

Altar	The table on which the priest celebrates Mass.
Consecration	At Mass when the Holy Spirit changes the bread and wine into the body and blood of Jesus.
Holy Communion	The body and blood of Jesus.
Last Supper	The last meal Jesus had with his friends before he died.
Liturgy of the Eucharist	The part in the Mass of the transformation of bread and wine into the body and blood of Christ.
My body, my blood	Words the priest says when holding the bread and the wine.
Offertory	In Mass where we bring gifts of bread and wine to the altar.
Penitential Rite	A form of words we use when we ask for forgiveness.
Sacrifice	To offer up something.
Sanctuary Lamp	A small lamp, usually red, placed near the Tabernacle, to remind us that God is truly present there.
Tabernacle	Place in the Church where Jesus' body, the consecrated host, is held for worship.
Temple	A special building where people prayed to God.
