



What should I already know?

- Children will know how we live as Christians.
- Children know who Jesus is.
- Children know the events of Holy Week.
- Children know that Holy Week precedes Easter.

What will I know at the end of the unit?

- Retell a narrative from Holy Week in sequence and detail e.g. Palm Sunday, The Last Supper, Good Friday.
- Describe, with increasing detail and accuracy, the actions of Jesus during the Last Supper - e.g. the bread and wine a sign of giving up his life and the gift of Holy Communion.
- Ask questions and suggest answers about how serving (putting others first), remembering, trust and standing up for your beliefs might make a difference to how they live after studying the stories of Holy Week.
- Make links between the Gospel texts and how Christians remember and celebrate the events of Holy Week.
- Make links to show how the feelings of Peter affected his behaviour.
- Give reasons for some symbols used in worship during Holy Week (palms, crucifix etc)
- Make links to show how the behaviour of Jesus was affected by his fear of what was to happen but also his belief in his mission.

Key Vocabulary

Betray	To break somebody's trust in you
Easter Sunday	The day when Jesus rose from the dead
Garden of Gethsemane	A Garden outside Jerusalem also known as the Mount of Olives where Jesus liked to pray
Good Friday	The day Jesus died
Holy Week	starts with Palm Sunday and ends with Easter Sunday, it's the most important time in the Church.
Last Supper	Jesus' last Passover meal with his disciples when he gave them the Sacrament of Eucharist for the first time
Messiah	Also known as "Christ". The leader longed for by the people of Israel. A Hebrew word meaning "anointed by God".
Miracle	When God does something wonderful that seems impossible
Passover meal	The special meal when the Jewish people remember their escape from Egypt
Palm Sunday	The Sunday before Easter Sunday when Jesus entered Jerusalem
Resurrection	When Jesus rose from the dead on Easter Sunday
Sacrament	Sacred signs instituted by God. Meeting points with God.
Saviour	The One who is to save us from sin

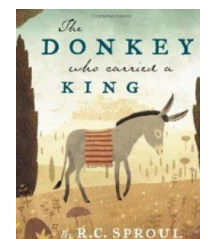
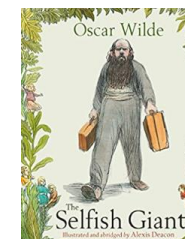
