- Children will be familiar with some of the parables Jesus told.


What will I know at the end of the unit?

- Describe the beliefs that Christians hold from God, from the given Beatitudes and parables.
- Give a point of view on an aspect of Jesus' teaching.
- Express a preference (e.g. 'which is, what is, which parable...what do you like/not like about...' etc on an aspect of learning from this unit.
- Suggests answers to questions like, 'How can God's Word grow in you?' 'Why is it important to forgive?'
