- Retell one of the stories of the Nativity of Jesus, ensuring it is accurate in its sequence and detail.
- Make a simple link between the Hail Mary and the stories of the Annunciation and Visitation.
- Make a simple link between the beliefs Christians hold about Christmas and how it
 affects their behaviour (e.g. think about practising the virtues and helping those who are
 lonely, those who are poor, visiting family etc).

Advent	Time in the church's year when we get ready for Jesus birth
Advent wreath	A circle of leaves, flowers and candles.
Annunciation	When the angel Gabriel brought God's message to Mary that
	He wanted her to be the mother of His son, Jesus
Blessed	made holy
Crib	A bed for a baby
Incarnation	When the Son of God became man
Nativity of Jesus	The birth of Jesus Christ
Saviour	A name given to Jesus, because he died and rose again to 'save' everyone from sin and death
Shepherds	A person who tends to and looks after sheep
Stable	A building where animals are kept
Visitation	The time when Mary went to visit her cousin Elizabeth
Worship	To adore, respect and praise
