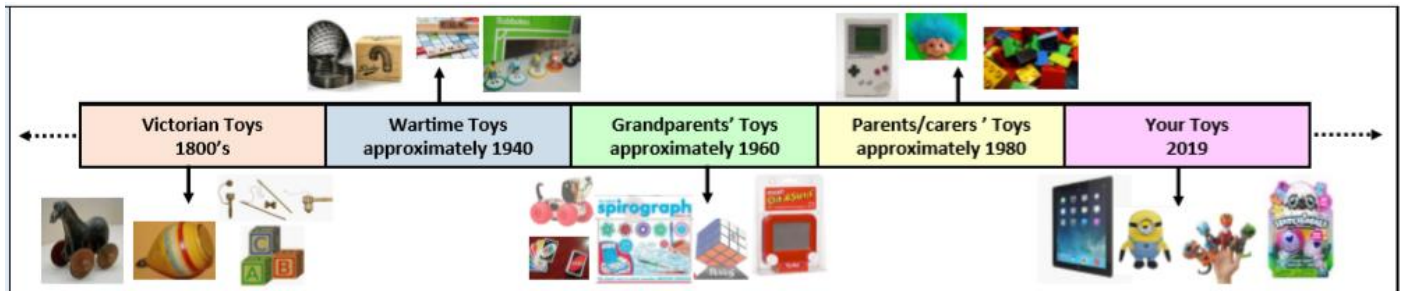


Year 1 – Toys – Spring 2
