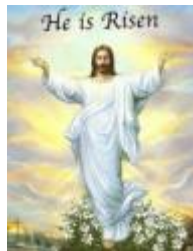

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• That Jesus died and rose from the dead at Easter</li> <li>• Some signs and symbols of Easter</li> <li>• What happened when Jesus was resurrected from the dead</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• I can recognise some stories of Easter and know they are from the Bible.</li> <li>• I can begin to retell in simple form a story of Easter and recognise a link with new life.</li> <li>• I can say what the stories of Easter tell Christians about Jesus.</li> <li>• I can talk, wonder and ask questions about whether the story of Easter has anything to say to me about joy, hope or new life.</li> <li>• I can recognise some symbols of Easter, e.g. cross (rather than crucifix), new life (spring, flowers), Easter eggs.</li> <li>• I can give at least two examples of how Christians show their beliefs about Jesus' Resurrection in worship at Easter.</li> <li>• I can say how at least two symbols are used at Easter.</li> <li>• I can give an answer to a question like, 'What makes you joyful?' or 'What do you hope for?'.</li> </ul>
