What should I already know?	What will I know at the end of the unit?	
 I know what happens during Holy Week and at Easter. I am aware of the resurrection of Jesus and the appearances he made once he rose from the dead. I know about the importance of the Holy Spirit. 	 I can retell one of the appearance stories of Jesus, ensuring it is accurate in its sequence and detail. I can make a simple link between the beliefs about Pentecost and how it can affect their behaviour, e.g. change in emotion and action, the Fruit of the Spirits. I can ask and respond to questions about their own and others experiences of sadness, loss, doubt, trust and joy. I can express a point of view about the resurrection. Using one appearance story, I can say what it teaches us e.g. Doubting Thomas, Jesus talking with Peter (John 21:15-17) I can make a simple link between the symbols used for the Holy Spirit (fire, wind, the colour red) and their meaning. After considering the story of Thomas, I can suggest answers to a question like, 'What helps you believe something is really true?'
