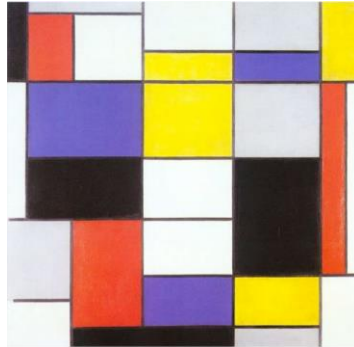
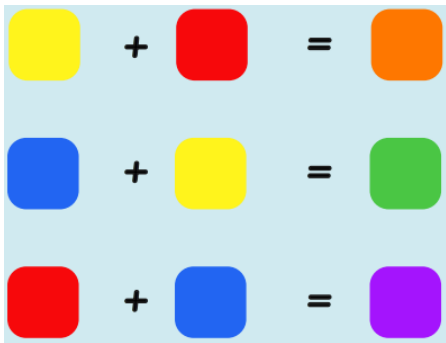



Enquiry Question: How many different colours can you see?

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Explore paint, using hands as a tool.</li> <li>• Describe colours and textures as they paint.</li> <li>• Explore what happens when paint colours mix.</li> <li>• Make natural painting tools. Investigate natural materials eg paint, water for painting.</li> <li>• Explore paint textures, for example mixing in other materials or adding water.</li> <li>• Respond to a range of stimuli when painting.</li> <li>• Use paint to express ideas and feelings.</li> <li>• Explore colours, patterns and compositions when combining materials in collage.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• To be able to identify colours and the objects that are associated with them.</li> <li>• To be able to identify primary colours.</li> <li>• To be able to mix primary colours to create secondary colours.</li> <li>• To be able to create light and dark shades of colour.</li> <li>• To be able to produce art based on the work of Kandinsky.</li> </ul>
