Year 4 – Sculpture and 3D – Can we change places? - Spring 1

Enquiry Question: What can we sculpt today?



What should I already know?	What will I know at the end of the unit?
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Join larger pieces of materials, exploring what gives 3D shapes stability. Shape card in different ways eg. rolling, folding and choose the best way to recreate a drawn idea. Plan a sculpture by drawing. Choose materials to scale up an idea. Create different joins in card eg. slot, tabs, wrapping. Add surface detail to a sculpture using colour or texture. Display sculpture 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use sketchbooks to research and present information. Join wire to make shapes by twisting and looping pieces together. Create a neat line in wire by cutting and twisting the end onto the main piece. Use a range of materials to make 3D artwork eg. manipulate light to make shadow sculpture, use recycled materials to make 3D artwork. Sculpt soap from a drawn design. Smooth the surface of soap using water when carving. Try out different ways to display a 3D piece and choose the most effective. Use a variety of methods to evaluate a piece of artwork.
