Enquiry Question: Who was Leonardo Da Vinci and what was he famous for?

















What should I already know?

- Mix a tint and a shade by adding black or white.
- Use tints and shades of a colour to create a 3D effect when painting.
- Apply paint using different techniques eg. stippling, dabbing, washing.
- Choose suitable painting tools.
- Arrange objects to create a still life composition.
- Plan a painting by drawing first.
- Organise painting equipment independently, making choices about tools and materials. Create a monoprint.

What will I know at the end of the unit?

- I can use my sketchbook to research and present information.
- I can use a photograph as a starting point for a mixed media artwork.
- I can adapt an image to create a new one, combine materials to create an effect and choose colours to represent an idea or atmosphere.
- I can explore inventions designed by Leonardo Da Vinci and develop a final composition from sketchbook ideas.
- I can take an interesting portrait photograph, exploring different angles.
- I can use a variety of methods to evaluate a piece of artwork.
